Summer School 2023

The Chilton School District once again will be providing summer school opportunities. As in the past, we continue to strive to provide a variety of opportunities to allow diverse options for our students. Summer School will run from 8:00-12:00 Tuesday May 30th - Thursday June 15th, with no classes on Friday.

Due to driveway and parking lot construction at the elementary and middle school, all classes will be held at the high school. All traffic for summer school will enter and exit from Highway 151 or Quinney Road. Parents will drop off and pick up students at Entrance A, the main entrance by the gym.

All classes will be 55 minutes in length. At 11:40 we will be providing free lunch to all students that attend summer school from 11:40-12:00 p.m. in the High School Commons. These lunches must be eaten at school. We do need some basic information from you to help us make sure we have the correct amount of food each day. During the registration process there will be a question that asks if your child would like to have lunch or not. This information is used to assist us in making the correct number of meals each day.

Classes will begin with students entering 5K and extend through high school. All students are able to select from a variety of options spanning from arts and crafts, sports, outdoor activities, and much more. We will also be offering remedial math and reading classes. We are excited to offer many great opportunities for each grade level and we hope all students are able to attend with the addition of bussing. If you are requesting bussing for your son or daughter you will need to make sure to select the box "transportation needed" when you register for classes. Bussing will be for anyone living 2 miles or further out from Chilton Middle School. The Chilton Library will be the location of an in-town drop off point. Buses will depart from the school at 12:00 p.m. each day at the completion of lunch.

The course catalog will be available on-line April 4th. On-line registration will be open April 25th through May 16th. Please log on to the school web page to access the summer school signup link. As we prepare for class sizes, teacher aides and staffing, we will not accept any late registrations. Class sizes are limited and will be offered on a first come first serve basis.
