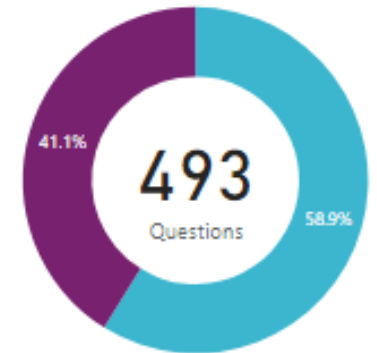
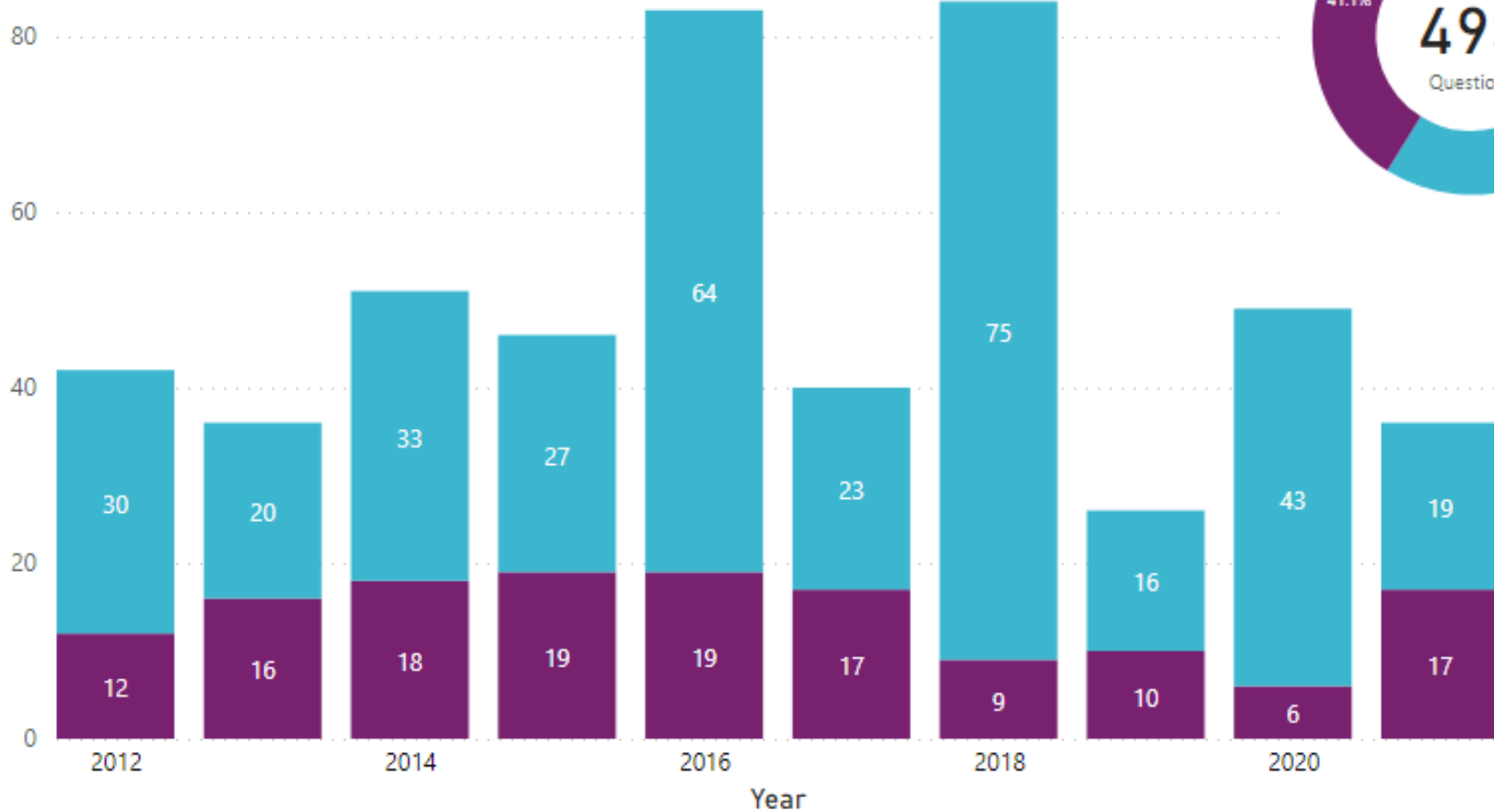

Long-Term Tax-Exempt Interest Rates

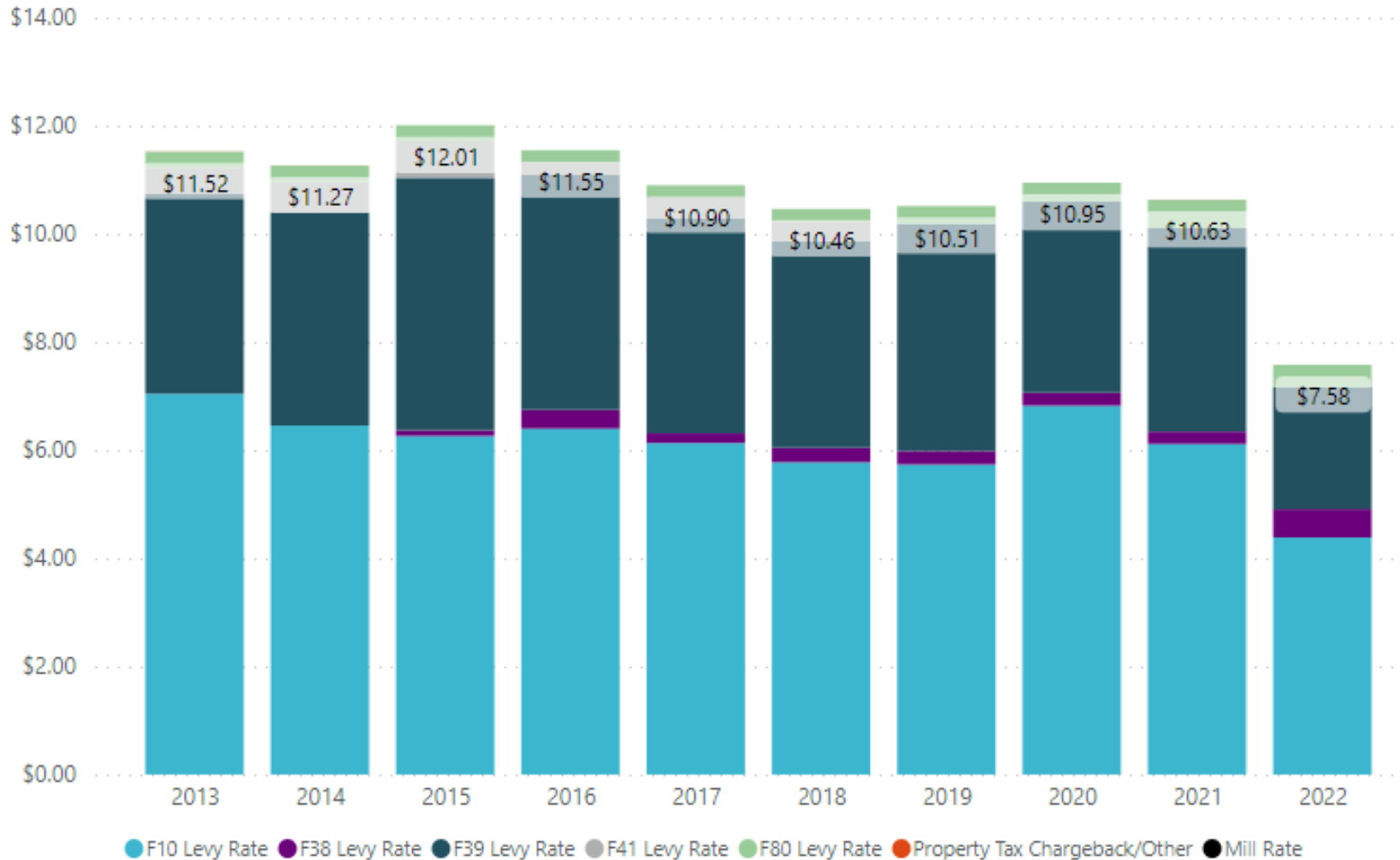
PAST 30 YEARS OF 20-YEAR MATURITY (AAA MMD)

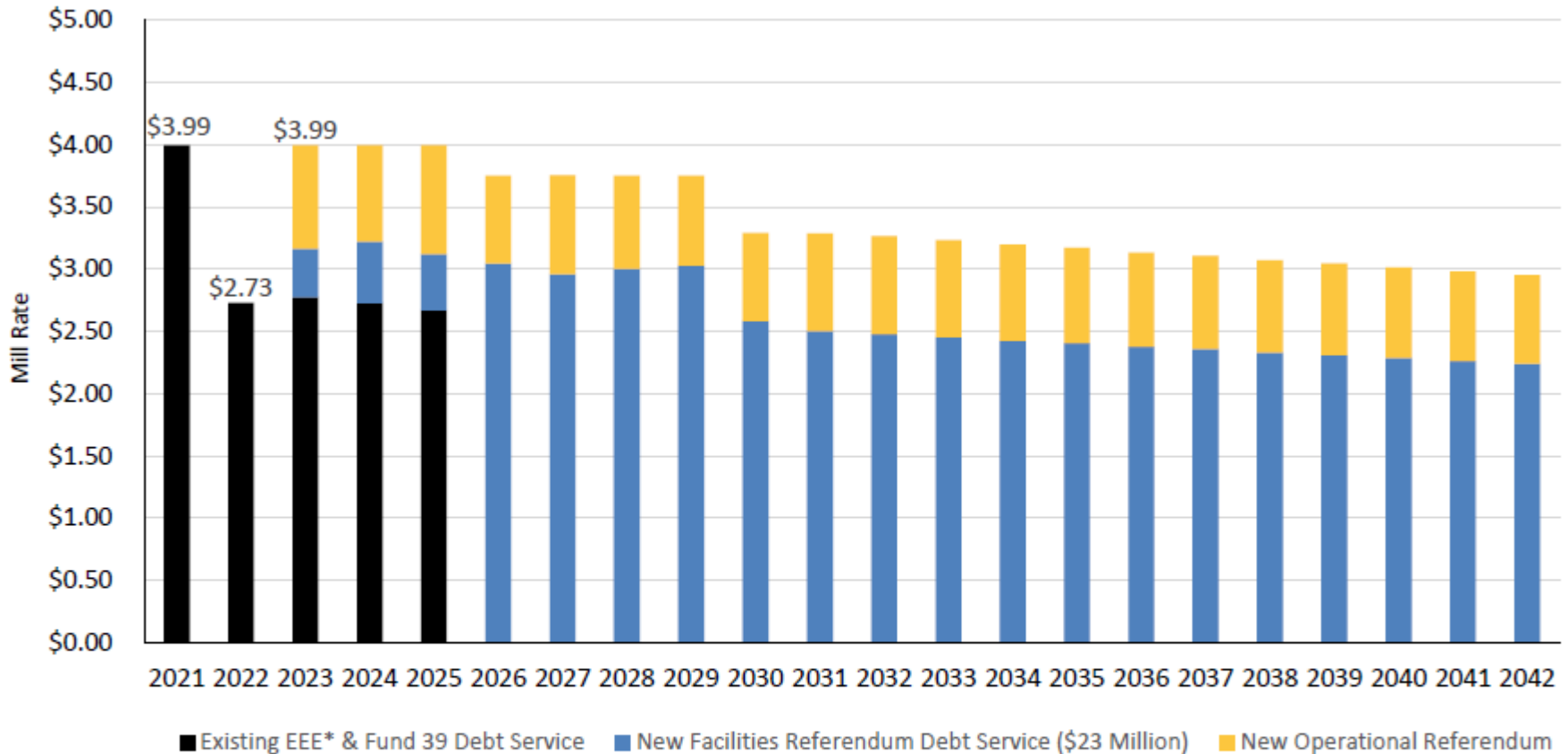
